

Stormin' Norman

IT would seem Chris Evert just can't get enough of Greg Norman. The former tennis star, now the wife of the Great White Shark, paid \$28,000 for a portrait of the Australian golfer at a charity dinner in Perth on Saturday night. The painting was done on the spot by Brian Olsen, an American artist who specialises in a form of painting he calls art in action. Along with brushes, Olsen uses his fingertips, palms and elbows to paint his portraits. In a five-minute flourish -- with AC/DC's Thunderstruck playing in the background -- Olsen produced a mega-sized portrait of Norman which had Evert immediately dipping into her wallet. Since their marriage last year, the pair have been inseparable. Evert has been at Norman's side throughout his visit to Perth, following him around The Vines course for the opening two rounds. Norman missed the cut but hung around for the dinner at Government House.
